

What are we measuring?

Rate of patients who developed thrombophlebitis after IV cannulation has been measured.

Why is this important?

Thrombophlebitis has negative consequences as far as loss of extremity. This is a very important performance criterion that requires follow-up and improvement works like other unwanted situations.

What does our performance tell us?

A lower score is better. The chart below shows the average rate of AHG is 0,037 percent and remained below the targeted value. This is a significant achievement in nursing performance.
